of CONTINENTAL LAW

The Summer University of the Foundation for Continental law is the international and yearly meeting place for persons interested in continental legal culture,

whether they are academic scholars, legal professionals or students. The Summer University provides two trainings courses, one in English-speaking, the other in French-speaking.

■ INTENDED AUDIENCE

This Summer University focuses on students having completed their legal studies' cycle, on professors and on professionals.

Last years, Summer Universities brought together near 120 students and professionals coming from more than 40 countries.

■ LOCATION and DATES

The Summer University takes place at the Paris 2 Panthéon-Assas, for 3 weeks, from Monday, 6 July to Friday, 24 July 2015.

■ APPLICATION

Registration fees include trainings courses, conferences, visits, the opening and closing cocktails and amount to :

400 euros without accommodation,

1 100 euros with accommodation at the Cité Internationale Universitaire de Paris

These fees receive financial support from the Foundation, which wishes to offer affordable rates in order to allow as many people as possible to participate.

Grants may, exceptionally, be granted upon specific and justified request.

■ TRAINING CONTENT

The training session lasts three weeks and includes a total of 60 class hours provided in **English** and in **French**, depending on the attendees' preferences.

The courses are delivered by high-level specialists, international eminent in continental law and in comparative law.

Professional conferences are scheduled so as to provide even greater depth of the courses materials.

Common core courses are the following: • The Civil Law Systems in a Comparative Perspective

• European and International Contract Law

Moreover, participants are required to choose four courses, among the five following proposed:

- Settlement of International Disputes
- Intellectual property
- Family Law
- Public Contract
- Civil Liability Law Compared

■ CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

The training is completed by cultural activities including visiting the highest institutions of the French law such as the Constitutional Council, Council of State, Court of Cassation and parliamentary assemblies, National Assembly and Senate.

■ EXAMINATION and CERTIFICATE

The final exam session is mandatory for all participants.

Students who would pass the final exam will be awarded by a certificate (master level) delivered by the Université Paris 2- Panthéon Assas.
