LOCATION and DATES

The Summer University takes place in Paris, at the Sorbonne, for 3 weeks.

This year, the Summer University will take place from Monday, 7 July to Friday, 25 July 2014.

APPLICATION

Registration fees include trainings courses, conferences, visits, the opening and closing cocktails and amount to .

TRAINING CONTENT

The training session lasts three weeks and includes a total of 60 class hours provided in **English** and in French, depending on the attendees preferences.

The courses are delivered by high-level specialists, international eminent (french, belgian, swiss, canadian, colombian) in continental law and in comparative law.

Professional conferences are scheduled so as to provide even greater depth of the courses materials.

Moreover, participants are required to choose 4 courses, among the 5 following proposed:

- Settlement of International Disputes
- Intellectual property

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

The training is completed by cultural activities including visitings the highest institutions of the French law such as the Constitutional Council, Council of State, Court of Cassation and parliamentary assemblies, National Assembly and Senate.

EXAMINATION and CERTIFICATE

The final exam session is mandatory, the certificate of training continental law is issued, by the Foundation, to all participants who have succeed, subject to a participation consistent with the requirements of the Foundation.

pplications must be submitted to the Foundation—through the form available on the website www.fondation-droitcontinental.org, by 10, April 2014.

Applications will be examined by the Scientific Council of the Foundation, which will select the candidates and decide whether to grant a scholarship.

As the number of participants is limited, it is recommanded to register now so that applications would be studied as soon as possible.
